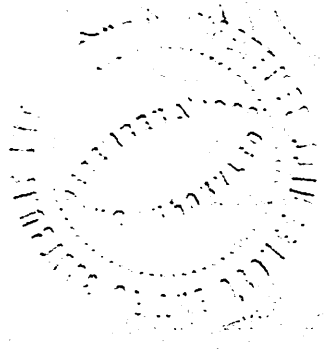

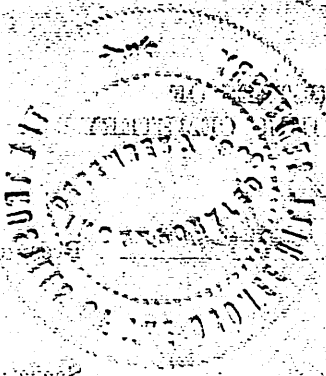

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION AND BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I. NAME AND PURPOSE. The name of this association shall be Oconee Hill Cemetery Trustees and its purpose shall be to acquire, hold, manage and dispose of the real estate known as Oconee Hill Cemetery in the County of Clarke, State of Georgia, and to erect and maintain thereon monuments and other structures for the burial of the dead.

ARTICLE II. MEMBERSHIP. Every person who has been elected or appointed by the Trustees shall be a member of this association and shall have the right to vote in the election of Trustees and to hold office as a Trustee.

ARTICLE III. OFFICERS AND DUTIES. The Trustees shall elect annually a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Trustees and shall see that the provisions of these Articles are carried into effect.

ARTICLE IV. MEETINGS. The Trustees shall meet at such times and places as they may determine. A majority of the Trustees shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

ARTICLE V. FINANCES. The Trustees shall have the right to borrow money and to incur liabilities for the purposes of this association. The Trustees shall also have the right to sell or lease any real estate owned by the association.

ARTICLE VI. AMENDMENTS. These Articles may be amended or repealed by a majority vote of the Trustees.

ARTICLE VII. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of these Articles is held to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.
