and it may be that the better plan will be to simply
keep the money in the bank at interest.

upon at the next meeting of the Board of Trustees.

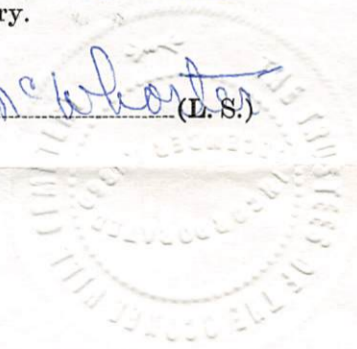

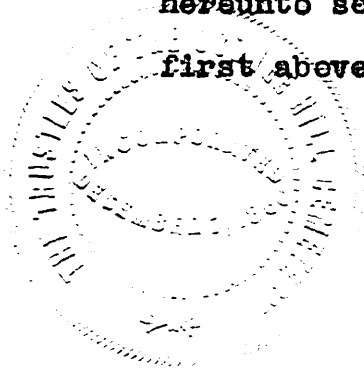
