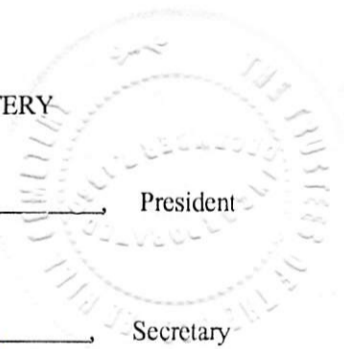

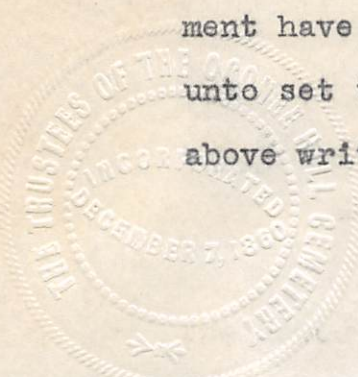

Dear Mr. Dozier,-

Your letter of May 5th, inclosing form of contract used by the Trustees of Oconee Hill Cemetery, in duplicate, in providing for perpetual care of burial lots, has been received. I have carefully noted same, together with your request for check in the amount of \$270.00 (two hundred and seventy dollars) as stipulated in the detailed list of measurements furnished by your Mr. Bisson, Superintendent, at my request some months ago, and am inclosing that amount in bank check from the Georgia Savings Bank & Trust Company to your order.

I will greatly appreciate your early attention to this duplicate contract for signatures, as my estate advisors have criticized my payment in advance of the receipt of a contract. I have felt confident, however, that the matter is in safe hands and that there is no reason for further delay. The object of my visit to Athens last week was to have this contract drawn up and paid at that time. I would have written to you in advance of my going had I known to whom the letter should have been addressed. Mr. Bisson had noted your name at the bottom of his correspondence, but I did not note its significance,- that you were the Trustee in charge. I was deeply sorry to miss you, but feel sure that the matter can be arranged satisfactorily by mail.

The old Lyle lot #34 in Oconee Hill Cemetery holds three (3) generations of my father's family,-the Great-Grandparents, the Grandparents and my parents, so that I am anxious to have it kept in order. The main trouble there is the proximity of a large oak tree that drops its acorns on the graves and produces small trees in short order. Three of them are to be removed at the present time by Mr. Bisson, to whom I paid the sum of five dollars (\$5.00) last week for this purpose, and the general destruction of weeds, in order that the perpetual care might begin with an orderly condition. *Golf since the retaining wall and head-*

stones are all in good shape. I understand that the City Council will not permit the removal of this large oak tree, and I would suggest the deep pruning of the limbs (in proper season) that molest these graves. I know that you must have many such problems in this historic place.

Perhaps the Crawford Long Memorial Association could be persuaded to pay for perpetual upkeep of the Long lot, nearby my own. Dr. Frank Boland, its President, I think, is a personal friend of mine, and, if you wish it, I will tell him of my own arrangement, as he often criticizes the condition of the Long lot. I can readily understand your problems during the present war labor shortage, of course.
